APPLICATIONS ARE TO BE SUBMITTED TO HLSA BY JUNE 15, AND MUST INCLUDE:

- A) Proof of enrollment in fall semester or acceptance by an ABET accredited college or university.
- B) Transcripts showing GPA (for proof of overall GPA)
- C) Brief written statement of:
 - 1) Financial Needs.
 - 2) Extra curricular activities.
 - 3) Goals (including applicant's plans for a formal education and career)
 - 4) Merit (awards by city, church, school, etc., or by performance; GPA, honors society, officer in organizations)
 - 5) Work History.

NOTE: The applicant's plans for a formal education and career, along with the statements of goals, merit, financial need and extra curricular activities shall consist of a minimum of one (1) page and maximum of five (5) pages.

SELECTION:

Selection will be made by the HLSA Awards Committee.

AWARD:

HLSA will notify the recipient of his/her selection by the committee. The recipient will receive a \$3,000 check. The award will be presented at a venue decided upon by the Board of Directors.

MINIMUM STANDARDS:

If items A, B and C are not complete the applicant will be disqualified and if in the considered judgment of the HLSA Awards committee no nominee is worthy of the award, no award will be made.
